## DOS

- \* DO register any changes in your information, including obtaining, changing, or losing a job, within 3 days
- \* DO return your re-registration form promptly \*\*Black ink pads can be purchased at a craft store.
- \* DO go to the post office immediately if you receive a postcard that you have certified mail—it is probably your re-registration letter
- \* DO ask questions if you are unsure of what you need to do.

## REMEMBER!


It is your responsibility to make sure your information on the registry is correct. If this information is incorrect, you could be charged with Fail to Register which can result in jail time, more frequent re-registration, supervised probation/parole, and/or placement on electronic monitoring.

## Purpose of the Registry

According to Virginia State Code, "the purpose of the registry shall be to assist the efforts of law enforcement agencies and others to protect their communities and families from repeat sex offenders and to protect children from becoming victims of criminal offenders by helping to prevent such individuals from being allowed to work directly with children."
