

Who has to register

In Virginia, every person convicted on or after July 1, 1994, of certain sexual offenses, including a juvenile tried and convicted in circuit court either as a juvenile or adult, is required to register and re-register. Additionally, every person who was on parole or supervised probation on or after July 1, 1994, resulting from certain sexual convictions is required to register and re-register.

VIOLENT SEX OFFENDER

Includes but is not limited to:

Rape, Forcible Sodomy, Indecent Liberties with Minor, Carnal Knowledge of a Minor (Victim ages 13-14) where the perpetrator is more than 5 years older than the victim, Production/Distribution/Financing etc. of Pornography

Must re-register every 90 days

Lifetime Registration

SEX OFFENDER

Includes but is not limited to:

Carnal Knowledge of a Minor (Victim Ages 13-14) if the perpetrator is less than 5 yrs older than the victim, Possession of Child Pornography, Sexual Battery (3 or more convictions), Enter Dwelling House, etc. w/Intent to Rape

Must re-register yearly

Can petition for removal from registry after 15 or 25 years

Registration Guidelines

Required to register or re-register at local police department, sheriff's office or state police office within 3 days of release from local jail, state facility, or juvenile correctional facility.

If active sentence not imposed, person must register within 3 days of suspension of sentence **for juvenile within 3 days of disposition

Law enforcement agency will obtain full fingerprints, palm prints, place of employment information (include part-time employment), proof of residence, and photograph. Additionally, law enforcement also required to obtain information of school registration, vehicle and/or boat registration information if vehicle and/or boat is registered in registrant's name, and email address.

ANY CHANGE in home address, employment information, school information, or vehicle information must be registered within 3 days of the change at your local law enforcement agency.

ANY CHANGE in email address must be registered within 30 minutes.

Turn RIGHT onto E MAIN ST/ US-60 W/ VA-147 S.
Turn LEFT onto S 8TH ST/ US-60 W.
Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto S 8TH ST/ US-60 W. Continue to follow US-60 W.
US-60 W becomes ramp.
Keep RIGHT at the fork to go on US-60.
Turn LEFT onto W ROANOKE ST/ US-60.
Turn RIGHT onto MIDLOTHIAN TURNPIKE/ US-60 W.
End at 7700 Midlothian Tpke Richmond, VA 23235-5226
